Advisory on Recording and reporting of COVID tests No 31/ F2/2020/ Health- 24th June2020

Kerala state is currently using RTPCR, CB NAAT (Xpert) and TrueNAT for the diagnosis of COVID. The state is also doing RTPCR based sentinel surveillance for obtaining early warning signals regarding community transmissions. Various SRF (Sample Request Forms) forms were in use for all these tests. ICMR introduced ICMR app in which details need to entered at district level and laboratories. The state intends to increase the average number of samples per day. In these contexts, following guidelines on recording and reporting of results have been laid down to maintain uniformity, sustain quality of reporting and ensure timely reporting.

Data entry in ICMR App & Portal

Details of all samples (routine/ sentinel surveillance/ TRUENAT/ CBNAAT, Surveillance testing by AB kits, Immuno Assay kits, Ag test kits) shall be entered at sample collection site using RTPCR App. District Surveillance Officer (DSO) will be responsible for the correctness and completeness of data entered in the app. With effect from 24/06/2020, Revised SRF (annexure1) need to be sent along with samples to the designated laboratories.

<u>Priority samples:</u> Samples of prisoners, samples of patients awaiting emergency medical or surgical intervention and post mortem samples shall be processed on a priority basis which should be mentioned in the SRF by the DSO.

Repeat samples: encircle "**RPT**" in the right upper corner of SRF if the sample is collected from a lab confirmed case of COVID 19 who is now under treatment.

Sentinel surveillance samples: ICMR Category can be entered as "others" in the RTPCR App. Sentinel surveillance group must be correctly entered in the revised SRF. The same will be entered in the ICMR portal by the laboratory in the remarks column in the format <u>SS numeric small letter alphabet</u> exactly as given in the 2nd page of SRF. If lab need to enter any other remarks, then add it after entering the group.

Eg: SS 3f, sample rejected due to inadequate VTM



Incomplete/ erroneous SRF: The samples with incomplete/ doubtful SRF especially with missing category/group shall not be processed/ reported from the lab until a corrected SRF is received from district authorities.

<u>Time limit</u>: Results must be entered in ICMR portal within 12 hours of testing including sentinel surveillance samples.

Data entry in State portal (https://healthmon.kerala.gov.in/rapidtest/)

- All positive results (Routine/ Sentinel/TRUENAT (step II) / CBNAAT) need to be entered on a real time basis.
- Update the daily summary of samples tested (12 noon previous day to 12 noon today) (Routine/ Sentinel/TRUENAT (step I) / CBNAAT) before 12.30pm every day.

Reporting of final results to districts

- All reports need to be reported from a single designated mail id to DSOs with appropriate subjects.
- Individual signed pdf documents need to be issued for positive cases & priority samples.
- Negative reports (not included in above categories) can be given as a group report based on district in pdf and excel format for the ease of sorting at district level.
- No parallel reporting of results should happen from laboratories. Lab- incharges will be responsible for all the results issued from laboratories. DSOs are responsible for the redistribution of reports to concerned authorities in the district without any time delay.
