

**Tender for outsourcing Ambulance services (See Notification no. NRHM/ BME/065/2010/SPMSU dated 08/12/2010)**

**Who can qualify?**

Organizations who have operated and managed at least three Advanced Life Support Ambulances in the state of Kerala  
Should have a set of trained Emergency Medical Technician and Drivers as Ambulance Staff

**Responsibility of the bidder will be**

To Operate and Manage Advanced Life Support Ambulances 24x7 in Government Hospitals under the supervision of the Concerned Medical Superintendent

The Bidder shall quote a price for running minimum 2000 Km per month per ambulance computed on an average basis for all 25 ambulances and the cost for running per kilometre above 2000km should be given

The Ambulance would be supplied with consumables

The Ambulances should be manned 24x7 with trained Emergency Medical Technician and Driver trained in Basic Life support
