ORDER

Smt. Manju.R, U.D.Clerk, SAT Hospital Thiruvananthapuram filed WP(C) No. 1623/10 before the Hon. High Court with a prayer to withdraw her option for transfer to Medical Education Service in view of abolition of Dual Control over Health Service Department staff working in the institutions under the Medical Education Service consequent to her illness. The Hon'ble High Court as per judgement 1<sup>st</sup> above has directed the first Respondent, Secretary to Government and Health and Family Welfare Department to consider the request made by the petitioner as per Expt.P4 while considering the grievance of the 6<sup>th</sup> respondent in terms of Ext P10 while considering the grievance of the 6<sup>th</sup> respondent in terms of Ext P10 if it had not been done so far.

Accordingly on receipt of the copy of the judgement Government have examined the case in detail.

The petitioner has represented that she was working as U.D.Clerk in Health Service Department w.e.f. 15.6.07. She is now undergoing treatment at Regional Cancer Centre, Thiruvananthapuram and will be put to hardships if transferred to Medical Education Service. The petitioner was heard in person on 29.3.2010. During the hearing she has substantiated with documents that she had undergone surgery at RCC, Thiruvananthapuram for the treatment of cancer and continuing the treatment reviews
